ABOUT 5 PERCENT OF 4-YEAR COLLEGE STUDENTS ARE INVOLVED WITH THE POLICE OR CAMPUS SECURITY AS A RESULT OF THEIR DRINKING, AND 110,000 STUDENTS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18 AND 24 ARE ARRESTED FOR AN ALCOHOL-RELATED VIOLATION SUCH AS PUBLIC DRUNKENNESS OR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE

TOP PICKS: SAFETY TIPS FOR STUDENTS

TOP 1 TIP



REMEMBER THE LOCATION OF EMERGENCY PHONES IN ACADEMIC BUILDINGS. ALSO, PHONES HAVE BEEN PLACED IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON CAMPUS. INSIDE BUILDING PHONES ARE SILVER IN COLOR. OUTSIDE PHONES ARE BLUE IN COLOR WITH "CAMPUS SAFETY" MARKED ON THE SIDE. BLUE LIGHT PHONES WILL DISPLAY A BLUE LIGHT AT THE TOP. IF YOU CAN'T GET TO SAFETY PHONE YOU CAN USE A MOBILE APP TO SEND AN SOS ALERT TO FRIENDS AND FAMILY IF YOU ARE IN TROUBLE.

TOP 2 TIP



IF THREATENED BY AN APPROACHING VEHICLE, RUN IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION. THE VEHICLE WILL HAVE TO TURN AROUND IN ORDER TO PURSUE YOU

TOP 3 TIP



IF YOU FIND THAT YOUR ROOM HAS BEEN ENTERED, DO NOT GO INSIDE. GO TO A NEIGHBOR AND CALL THE CAMPUS SAFETY DEPARTMENT. IF YOU ARE ALREADY INSIDE, DO NOT TOUCH ANYTHING. YOU MAY DISTURB EVIDENCE THAT IS IMPORTANT TO THE POLICE INVESTIGATION.

TOP 4 TIP



WHEN OUT AT NIGHT, TRY TO HAVE A FRIEND WALK WITH YOU... HAVE THE REACT MOBILE APP OPEN TO ALERT FAMILY AND FRIENDS IF YOU ARE IN TROUBLE AND THEY WILL RECEIVE A SMS TEXT MESSAGE AND AN EMAIL WITH YOUR GPS LOCATION.

TOP 5 TIP



CALL AHEAD WHEN DRIVING TO YOUR HOME OR APARTMENT LATE NIGHT AND HAVE SOMEONE WATCH YOU WALK FROM YOUR CAR TO THE RESIDENCE.

TOP 6 TIP



IF YOU THINK SOMEONE IS FOLLOWING YOU, SWITCH DIRECTIONS OR CROSS THE STREET. IF THE PERSON CONTINUES TO FOLLOW YOU, MOVE QUICKLY TOWARD AN OPEN STORE OR RESTAURANT OR A LIGHTED HOUSE. DON'T BE AFRAID TO YELL FOR HELP.
