

Nursing In Crisis

Hospital IQ's survey of over 200 hospital registered nurses shows frontline nurses in a state of crisis due to overwhelming stress, increasing patient ratios, and more.



90%

of nurses are considering leaving the nursing profession



72%

of nurses had already experienced professional burnout prior to Covid-19

Burnout is highest among nurses with 11-15 years of experience (**83%**)

ONLY 24%

are planning to stay with their current hospital



100%

of nurses report negative personal and professional effects from being understaffed

Professional

- » More time on administrative tasks
- » Extreme amounts of overtime
- » Making mistakes they've rarely/never made

Personal

- » Anxiety or depression
- » Excessive amounts of stress and fatigue
- » Feeling overwhelmed or trapped
