

WHAT TYPE OF OIL LAWN MOWER TAKES?

Every machine needs the right kind of oil suitable for its engine and will help it run smoothly over its lifespan. The lawn mower is no different from that.



TYPES OF LAWN MOWER OILS



10W30 is a common motor oil grade suitable for many lawn mowers. All reputable oil includes a service rating in addition to a viscosity rating. Look for oil that's designated SF, SG, SH, SJ or higher.



Single grade oil - A single grade level oil typically without additives to change its viscosity and represented only at higher temperatures (100°C).



Multi grade oil - multi grade level oil that uses additives to provide better viscosity at various temperatures.



Synthetic blend oil - A mixture of regular and synthetic oil with additives to help perform at colder temperatures without the cost of a full synthetic oil.



Full Synthetic Oil - An artificially created lubricant with a wide range of benefits designed for use in high performance and commercial engines

SAE 30 Oil:

Engine oil is best suited for warmer temperatures.

SAE 5w-30 Synthetic Oil:

Synthetic mower oil is good for warm and cold weather.

10w-30 Synthetic Oil:

Synthetic oil can help in colder temperatures.

15W-50 Synthetic Oil:

Synthetic oil is typically used for high-end and commercial engines.
