

Each player should choose their hand values based on potential winning hands before the game starts. Based on the cards they have in hand, each player calls or bids the number of tricks they believe they can win.


In the call-break game, spades are the Ione trump suit.

Four players are required to play this gam

Any card from a different suit will lose to a spade card. For instance, the 2 of Spades has more strength than any other suit's Ace.
A player must throw a spade card if they don't have any cards in the suit being played. He or she may throw any card of their choosing if they do not have any spade cards.

> If one of the following players does not receive a spade suit (trump) card, the round should be redone. b) When a player fails to draw a face card ( $J, Q, K$, or $A$ ) of any suit. c) There are fewer than eight calls (bets) in total.
