

PHILODENDRON



Indirect sunlight of about 4-6 hours with partial shade



Only make the soil or potting medium moist at regular intervals not to make a soggy environment.



Application of any diluted organic fertilizer monthly once. Over the soil & also foliar spray over the leaves.



Ever remember to clean philodendron leaves in 4 to 5 days' intervals wipe the leaves with a wet soft cloth. It helps plant to get a fresh look and healthier growth.



Trim the old, matured plant parts which turns yellow.



Soil to be well-drained, and fertile with good organic content. In the case of coco peat, it needs to be porous and well-aerated.

CUSTARD APPLE



Prefer to grow in full sunlight for at least six to twelve hours.



To deep-level watering when the plant's top 1-inch soil was dry.



Apply any organic manure like cow manure in early spring. To prevent mealy bugs use neem oil in the foliar spray method.



Fruits have a delicious taste and soft creamy white flesh. Best for medicinal purposes to treat diabetes, skin, hair, digestion problems, and cancer.



Trim and thin the branches and maintain plant height.



Love to grow all types of soil especially organically rich well-draining soil.

Water the 3 weeks once as they are drought tolerant.
