

# PHILODENDRON



Indirect sunlight of about 4-6 hours with partial shade



Only make the soil or potting medium moist at regular intervals not to make a soggy environment.



Application of any diluted organic fertilizer monthly once. Over the soil & also foliar spray over the leaves.



Ever remember to clean philodendron leaves in 4 to 5 days' intervals wipe the leaves with a wet soft cloth. It helps plant to get a fresh look and healthier growth.



Trim the old, matured plant parts which turns yellow.



Soil to be well-drained, and fertile with good organic content. In the case of coco peat, it needs to be porous and well-aerated.
