

Top 9 Horror Movie



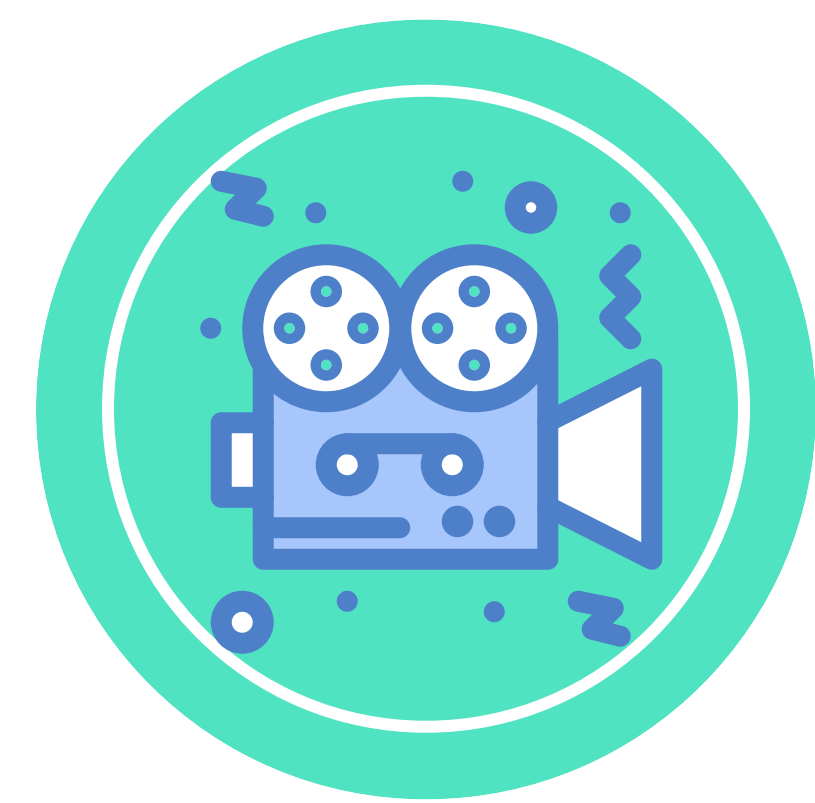
The Shining (1980)

Directed by Stanley Kubrick and based on Stephen King's novel, "The Shining" follows the story of Jack Torrance, a writer who becomes the winter caretaker of the Overlook Hotel, where sinister supernatural forces drive him to madness.



Psycho (1960)

Directed by Alfred Hitchcock, "Psycho" revolves around Marion Crane, who encounters the enigmatic Norman Bates at the secluded Bates Motel, leading to a series of terrifying events.



Get Out (2017)

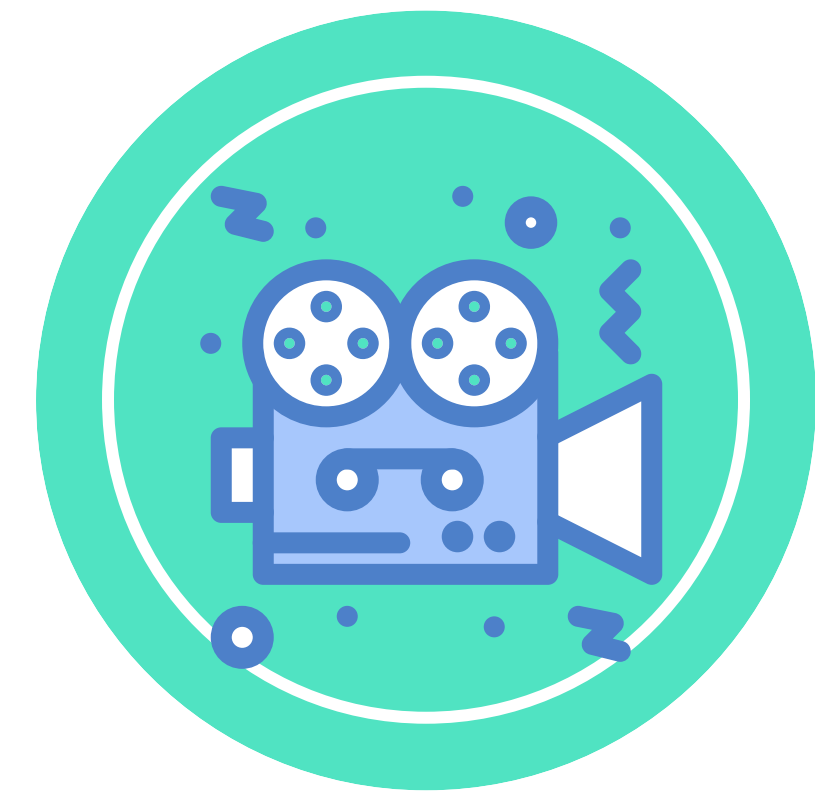
Halloween (1978)
